The **Accreditation of Inventors' Organization (AIO) Program** is mandated to accredit and recognize inventors' organizations throughout their activities.

CRITERIA

1. The organization must have a de jure (in law) or de facto (in fact) existence for at least one year
2. It must have at least three members with active patents, utility model (UM), or industrial design (ID) registration.
3. The members whose registrations are submitted for criteria two can no longer be used by other inventors' organization where they may also belong
4. No member can be elected officer and hold key position in more than one organization at the same time except for their own umbrella organizations

REQUIREMENTS

- Letter of request for accreditation
- Copy of SEC or CDA registration papers or any government regulatory body
- Certified copy of patent, UM, or ID registration of at least three members
- Roster of active members
- Barangay certification of organization's existence
- Certificate of participation in any inventor-related activities
- List of current officers or board of directors
- Organizational profile
