The **Invention-Based Enterprise Development (IBED) Component II** covers the production costs of the invention in response to the additional requirements of the market in satisfying the unmet demand. Previous assistance from DOST-TAPI for pilot production must have been completed to qualify for the Phase II Program. Also, the business must have been able to register as an enterprise. Additional funds to produce the invention in a commercial scale is required to meet the current market demands and sustain the existing market for commercialization.

- Endorsement letter from DOST Regional Office and the Regional Technical Evaluation Committee Report (if applicable)
- Project proposal
- List of prospective clients or users
- Letter of intent specifying the five (5) percent commitment fee on the amount of requested orders (with proof of payment)
- Patent letters
- Test results (if any)

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- Copies of the business registration papers
- Assigned co-implement for inventors over 60 years
